- Not as easy as it sounds.....
 1. Find good, water free oil
 2. Contract with the restaurant
 3. Try not to upset the local renderer

Federal Clean Waterways Act

- Mandates the monitoring of public waterways for pollution
- Local counties given authority to regulate
- Many require permits to collect oil
- They dictate the terms of the permit

Salt Lake County, Utah

- Permit Requirements
 - Pay \$125 per year permit fee
 - Carry General Liability Insurance Policy
 - \$1 Million in environmental coverage
 - Carry a \$5,000 Bond
 - Inspection of collection vehicle
 - Proof of proper disposal of waste products
 - Glycerin & Waste Water
 - Clearly display name & phone # on collection vehicle
 - Name & phone # on all collection barrels
 - Permit clearly displayed in vehicle window

The Problem

1. Only businesses can get a General Liability Insurance Policy
2. Bonds are difficult to obtain
3. No mercy from the county

So what to do?

1. Develop a “coop” oil collection & distribution group
2. Become permitted
3. Go underground & hope not caught
 - Renderer is turning in any “foreign barrels” to the health department
 - Extremely unforgiving
 - No interest in cooperating
